Mr. Sones, his wife Blanche, and their three children—Wendy, Todd, and Beth—live at 1 Country Club Lane in Ontario.

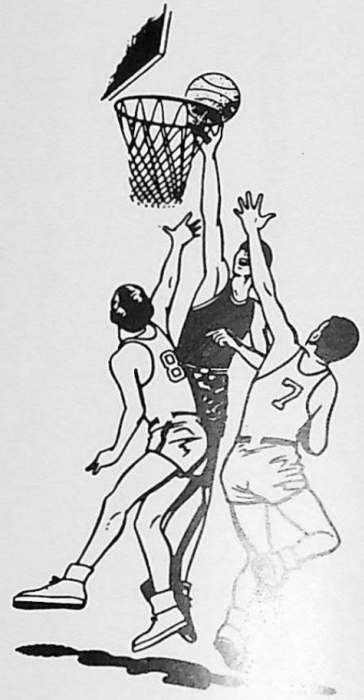

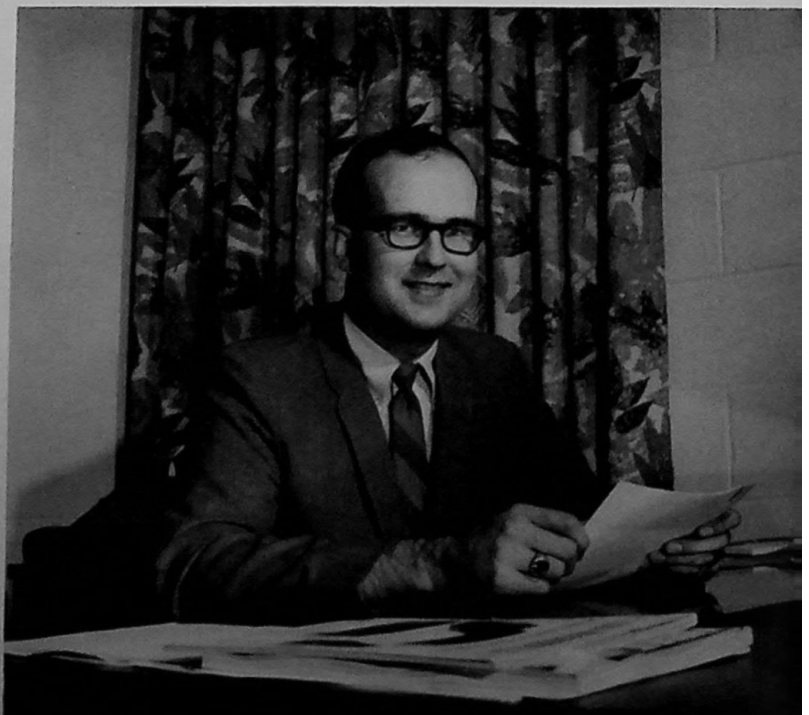
Dear Students,
